

Jewish Havana 7 days – 6 nights Havana, Old Havana, Viñales Heritage, History, Culture

Day 1- Wed: Hayana

Upon arrival in Havana's Jose Marti International airport you will be met by your guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. time to rest and relax until time for dinner at private restaurant. Later witness, the nine o'clock Cannon Blast Ceremony at the San Carlos de la Cabana Fortress, one of the oldest traditions of colonial era Cuba that still takes place. The cannon shot signaled the closing of the city walls during the colonial era. After dinner you will go to "La Zorra y el Cuervo", the best-known jazz club in Havana for a late night jazz session. Return transportation by taxi is at own cost that is both safe and easily arranged at the show's entrance Accommodation in your hotel. [D]

Day 2- Thu: Havana (Old Havana & Art tour)

After breakfast start a City Encounter of Havana, a walking tour through Old Havana and its five main plazas, with stops at the residence of the colonial era Captain General of the island, the Havana Cathedral, Obispo Street, the Capitol building, and more. Most of our quests in Cuba start their cultural exchanges with a walking tour of Old Havana. This event is directed by one of our professional English-speaking guides, and gives you a taste of the island in a very interesting activity that feels like stepping into a time machine. Old Havana has buildings and streets that are some of the oldest in the Americas, with some buildings dating to the 17th century. Though the buildings are hundreds of years old, they are still used to house a significant number of Havana's inhabitants. Old Havana features the first church built on the island, a street paved with wooden bricks, palatial residences, and much more! Old Havana is one of the largest, oldest, most authentic colonial areas in Latin America, and houses a significant number of Havana's population. Lunch at a private restaurant. In the afternoon visit the Museo de Bellas Artes currently housed in 2 buildings. One for the international collection (Coleccion de Arte Universal) in the former Centro Asturiano, a beautiful Spanish Renaissance building dating to 1927 that we'll admire from the outside, exhibits works from important world artists. The other, installed in a modern building across from the Revolution Museum and called the Colección Cubana, harbors more than 30,000, works from Cuban artists from the 16th century to the present day. We'll have a tour of this section lead by the curator to browse art of renowned painters such as Lam, Mialhe, Pelaez and Puerto Carrero. In the evening enjoy dinner at a private restaurant and visit "La Fabrica de Arte Cubano," for an art exhibit and live music. Return transportation by taxi is at own cost that is both safe and easily arranged at the show's entrance Accommodation in your hotel. [B/L/D]

Day 3- Fri: Havana (Jewish Center & Shabbat dinner)

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel and attend a welcome ceremony at Havana's Jewish Community Center in Vedado, including tour of the facility and brief discussion about the history of the Jewish Community in Cuba, current programs and projects, a question and answer session, and visit to the Beth Shalom Synagogue. Have lunch at a private restaurant before visiting "La Lavanderia", the studio of Cuban artist Rafael Perez Alonso. This afternoon you'll have free time with the car and driver at your disposal. Early evening attend Friday services at Beth Shalom Synagogue followed by a Shabbat dinner including Kiddush. After dinner return to your hotel. [B/L/D]

Day 4-Sat: Havana

Breakfast and free day to rest and relax or to continue discovering Havana on your own. Lunch and dinner are included. [B/L/D]

Day 5-Sun: Havana, Viñales, Havana

Early breakfast before today's full-day tour to discover the UNESCO protected "Valle de Viñales," and its unique rock formations. Tour includes the "Mirador de los Jazmines", the "Cueva del Indio" (the cave of the Indian), - that includes a boat ride through its interior. Visit to a Tobacco Farm and the "Casa del Veguero," - the cigar maker's home. Lunch at a local restaurant before concluding your tour with a visit to the Prehistoric Painting Mural, which illustrates the evolution of life in the "Sierra de los Organos". Return to Havana arriving in time for dinner at your hotel. [B/L/D]

Day 6-Mon: Havana (Jewish Heritage)

Today will be dedicated to Cuba's Jewish Heritage visiting Havana's Sephardic Jewish Center, Holocaust Memorial, and the Guanabacoa Cemetery. Lunch at private restaurant. In the afternoon we'll tour the Old Havana sites related to Cuba's Jewish Community and the Adath Israel Synagogue.

This evening we'll have a farewell dinner at a private restaurant and, after, live music at the Buena Vista Social Club. [B/L/D]

Day 7-Tue: Havana, USA

After breakfast be ready for your transfer to Jose Marti International Airport at least 3 hours before your return flight's departure time. [B]
