Travel from Arequipa to Cusco in unforgettable style. Savor the unforgettable indulgence of the Belmond Andean Explorer train as you are whisked through Peru's most spectacular destinations, including the spellbinding Lake Titicaca. The Andean Plains and Islands of Discovery journey departs every Saturday night.

Day 1- Sat: Arequipa

Upon arrival at Arequipa International Airport you'll be met and transferred to the Baroque city of Arequipa to board the train. Take some time to get comfortable in your cabin and acclimatize to the indulgent atmosphere of the train as you begin your journey towards Puno. Take your seat in one of the elegant dining cars for your first dinner on board. Relax and savor refined Andean dishes served with contemporary flair. After dinner, why not head to the bar car and enjoy a cocktail as you get to know your fellow travelers. [D]

Day 2 - Sun: Arequipa, Puno (Lake Titicaca)

Awake early for a spellbinding experience as you witness the sunrise across Lake Titicaca. Breakfast served on board, the perfect set up for a day full of adventure. This afternoon we explore Lake Titicaca, the highest navigable lake in the world. The beautiful lake is home to many diverse islands, each boasting a unique way of life. First, we take a traditional boat to Uros, a man-made island artfully constructed from interwoven reeds which are constantly being replenished. The people who live on the island use the same reeds to create homes, ships and tools. Continue your exploration to Taquile Island, notable for its stunning agricultural terraces. The people here follow a social code that has been barely touched by time and their handwoven fabrics are regarded as the best in Peru. Enjoy lunch at Collata Beach, followed by a performance from local dancers and a demonstration of artisans at work. Return to the station at the lake for a delicious sternson tea. Board the train and relax as the journey continues on to Cusco. As the evening descends enjoy another tempting dinner in the dining carriage. [B/L/D]

Day 3 - Mon: Puno, Cusco

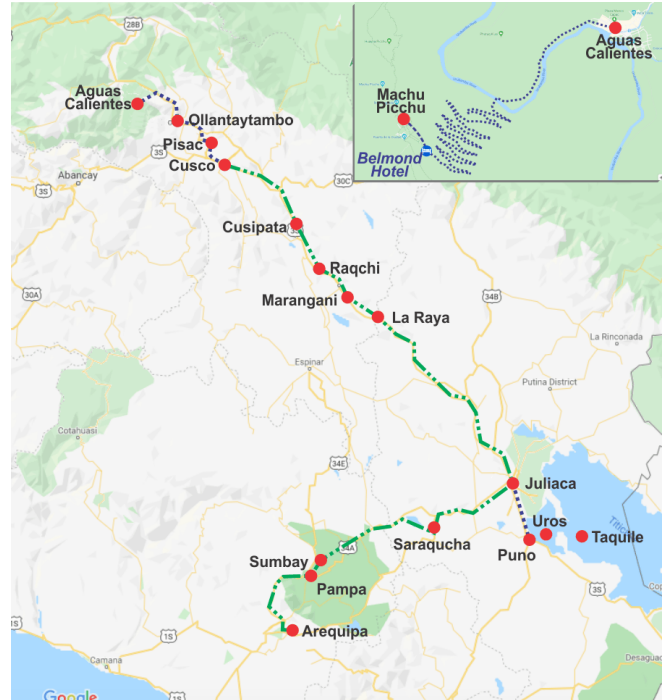
Wake to a delicious breakfast, accompanied by stunning views as the train sets off from Marangani. Along the way, disembark to visit Raqchi. Once an important Inca settlement, today this fascinating archeological site boasts many architectural gems. After, enjoy a delicious brunch in the bar cars. All too soon we arrive at Cusco, the former capital of the Inca Empire. Bid farewell to your crew and disembark to meet our representatives and transfer to hotel. Rest of the morning to relax and acclimatize to the altitude. You may want to take a walk around the hotel before dinner. [B/L/D]

Day 4 - Tue: Cusco

After breakfast at the hotel, visit the city of Cusco, declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO and place of a particular essence. The tour begins in the temple of Koricancha, an ancient Inca palace and main center of worship of the god Sol, where after the Dominican order built a church that lies prized so far. Then visit the Plaza de Armas, where the Cathedral and the beautiful church of the Jesuits, among other colonial buildings, are located. Continue the journey to the colonial church of San Cristobal to enjoy a spectacular view of the city. Enjoy lunch a local restaurant and continue to the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman, an Inca construction that stands out for its huge walls of hewn stone, located in a strategic position on a hill, with a broad view of the city of Cuzco. Later you will visit important archaeological sites Puca Pucara and Qenko and return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. [B/L/D]

Day 5 - Wed: Cusco, Machu Picchu

Early breakfast at the hotel before your transfer to the station for embarkation on the Hiram Bingham luxury train. A visit to a once-in-a-lifetime place calls for a once-in-a-lifetime journey. Sink into an armchair in the 1920s-style carriages, where polished wood and brass catch the light. Make your way to the Observation Car to watch the sun rise or give way to starry skies. Your Peruvian adventure has begun. Heading towards Machu Picchu, your experience begins with a delicious welcome cocktail. Then savor a brunch and gourmet lunch as you admire the ever-changing scenery in the early light. You'll also have the chance to dance to the beat of the Peruvian cajón and tambourines with traditional live music. Visit Machu Picchu mystical city of the Incas guided by an experienced official guide, wander in the ruins and admire breath-taking views of the valley. Find your luggage at the hotel, check-in and prepare yourself for a delicious dinner. Machu Picchu is there, just for you and the few guests at the lodge. [B/L/D]



Day 6 - Thu: Machu Picchu Sacred Valley of the Incas, Cusco

Some free time for a last look at this amazing place before you our representative picks you up for a day in the Sacred Valley of the Incas, along the river Urubamba. First, we spend some time at Ollantaytambo, the oldest continuously occupied settlement in the Americas, its narrow streets and canals unchanged since Inca times. In it, we see the fortress of Ollantaytambo archaeological complex with terraces and stone walls carved with a dazzling technique. On the way to Cusco, we stop at Moray to see the Inca terraces on the high plateau. Then, continue to Pisac for lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch we traverse the colorful market of Pisac, where you can see a blend of color, tradition and local people exhibiting typical products, silver handicrafts, alpaca and ceramics. Nearby is Awanakancha where you will discover the beauty of South American camelids: guanacos, llamas and alpaca's single species, and an exhibition of traditional Andean textile art. Our last stop is at Tambomachay, Baño del Inca in Spanish, due to its complex network of canals, aqueducts and waterfalls that run through the old city. Continue to Cusco for dinner and overnight at the hotel. [B/L/D]

Day 7 - Fri: Cusco, USA

At the appropriate time, our representative will assist you on your transfer to airport to board your flight to Lima for a connection to your international flight back home. [B]
