Czestochowa: The Black Virgin Mary of Jasna Gora 7 days – 5 nights Warsaw, Czestochowa, Auschwitz-Birkenau, Wadowice, Wieliczka, Krakow Faith, Art, History, Culture, Fun

Day 1: USA, Warsaw


Depart the USA on an overnight flight to Warsaw. Dinner and breakfast served on board.

Day 2: Warsaw, Czestochowa

Upon arrival you'll be met and transferred to Czestochowa for check-in at your hotel. The rest of the day is free to rest and relax. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. [D]

Day 3: Czestochowa (Jasna Gora)

After breakfast at the hotel start today's pilgrimage to the Sanctuary of the Black Virgin Mary of Jasna Gora. Millions of pilgrims from all over the world come to Częstochowa to see it. The city of Czestochowa is an important religious sanctuary connected with the icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa, better known as the Black Madonna. There have been reports for centuries of miraculous events occurring to those who made a pilgrimage to the unique portrait. While the portrait is what the pilgrims mostly focus on, also the votive offerings collected in the monastery given to the Black Madonna over the centuries are worth seeing. Gifts range from swords and scepters to rosaries made of dried bread in concentration camp. Visit the Sanctuary including the Treasury Museum and the ancient weapons' collection. After dinner participate in the



prayer of the "Appeal to the Virgin Mary". Overnight in Czestochowa. [B/D]

Day 4: Czestochowa (Auschwitz-Birkenau, Wadowice)

Depart for Krakow, en route stop to Oswiecim (Auschwitz), to visit the former Nazi concentration camp. The Auschwitz-Birkenau Memorial and Museum – which is listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List – makes an unforgettable impression on every visitor. Every year, millions of visitors walk through the gate with the cynic motto "Arbeit macht frei" (Work will set you free). The tour begins with a 15-minute documentary movie about the history of the camp. Then, the guide will lead you through Konzentrationslager Auschwitz I, showing the surviving prison blocks, the gas chamber and the crematorium. The second part of your visit will cover the Auschwitz II Birkenau camp, where you can ascend the watchtower above the entrance gate to catch a view over the whole area of both concentration camps. After the visit continue to Wadowice, birthplace of Pope Saint John Paul II, one of the most significant persons in the history of the world. This modest city where he spent his childhood is definitely worth seeing, not only for the ones who truly loved the Pope, but also for others who would like to know the biography of Karol Wojtyla. Visit the birthplace of John Paul II and the Basilica of the Virgin Mary with the Sacred Familiy Chapel where John Paul II was baptized. After the visit return to Czestochowa for dinner and overnight at the hotel. [B/D]

Day 5: Czestochowa, Wieliczka, Krakow

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before a 2-hour drive to Krakow for a pilgrimage to the Sanctuary of the Divine Mercy, where the body of St. Faustina Kowalska is venerated. Visit the historical capital of Poland: St. Mary's Basilica, the Barbican, the Wawel Royal Castle and the Wawel Cathedral. In the afternoon drive to Wieliczka for an excursion to the salt mines; its underground itinerary tunnels are 2.2 miles long. Visit the Chapel of St. Kinga located 330 ft. below ground with crystal salt chandeliers and grey salt sculptures. The miraculous image of Merciful Jesus painted by Adolf Hyła is placed above the side altar on the left side of the chapel. The altar was blessed by Father Józef Andrasz, SJ (Sister Faustina's spiritual director) on 16 April 1944, on the first Sunday after Easter. Copies and reproductions of the image have spread throughout the world, thereby fulfilling the words of Jesus spoken to Sister Faustina at the first of His revelations: "I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and [then] throughout the world" (Diary 47). Check-in at the hotel in Krakow, dinner and overnight. [B/D]

Day 6: Krakow, Warsaw

Drive to Niepokalanow, founded by St. Maximilian Mary Kolbe, a martyr of charity from the concentration camp in Auschwitz. Tour of the Franciscan Fathers' Monastery and the Museum of St. Maximilian Kolbe and continue to Warsaw to visit: the Cathedral of St. John, the Church of the Holy Cross, the Old City and the Market Square. After check-in at the hotel rest a few minutes and prepare for today's farewell dinner at a typical restaurant. Return to the hotel for overnight. [B/D]

Day 7: Warsaw, USA

After breakfast at your hotel, get ready to be picked-up for your transfer to Warsaw Airport to board your flight back home. [B]
