

**Embrace Dalmatia Cruise**  
**aboard Captain Bota**

**Split, Brac (Bol), Hvar, Mljet, Dubrovnik, Korčula, Makarska, Pucisca**

The brand-new Captain Bota is a gem in the fleet of yacht-like ships built in the Split shipyard according to the latest EU standards applicable to small ship cruising. With the friendly crew of 7 members Captain Bota offers an intimate atmosphere accommodating up to 38 passengers in her 18 spacious cabins with private facilities and air conditioning. Nicely appointed public areas located on the upper deck include a spacious restaurant with panoramic windows adjacent to a large terrace with deck chairs and tables where you can spend your time at leisure and enjoy your open-air breakfast. For swim lovers there is a large platform with two ladders as well as public showers. Sundeck with loungers on the top most level measures 250 square meters and features a wow factor – an open-air Jacuzzi.*

**Day 1: Split**

Our cruise conveniently embarks in Split, the largest Dalmatian city. The M/S Captain Bota will be docked in the main Split harbor and the cabins will be at your disposal starting from 13:00 (1:00 p.m.). Please feel free to leave your luggage on board in case of your earlier arrival. Meet your fellow passengers, the Captain and our friendly crew over welcome reception followed by dinner at 19:30 (7:30 p.m.). Dinner meal will be also served to the guests arriving with late evening flights. Overnight stay in Split. [D]

**Day 2: Split, Brac (Bol), Hvar**

We start our day with the morning departure towards Bol situated on Brac Island. Bol is well known for its pebbled beach called Zlatni Rat, claimed to be the most beautiful beach on the Croatian coast. Immerse yourself in a bath of sun and sea water or explore the town of Bol before lunch and continuation of our journey to Hvar where we will arrive in the late afternoon/early evening hours. Experience the enchanting town of Hvar situated on the island of the same name. Hvar is claimed to be the most popular Croatian island which you may realize while feeling the vibe of its bustling promenade, well-appointed cafes, wine stores, shops and restaurants. Join an evening walking tour to learn on the history and heritage of Hvar followed by presentation of centuries long lavender farming tradition. Overnight stay in Hvar. [B/L]

**Day 3: Hvar, Mljet**

We start our day with morning departure towards the island of Mljet with a swim stop along a way. Lunch will be served on board while cruising to Mljet National Park. Upon arrival to the Mljet National Park, you will have free afternoon to explore park (entrance fees are not included), to walk around the Great and Small Lake and Islet of St. Mary with its Benedictine Monastery from the 12th century. We will have Captain's dinner that evening on board. Overnight in Mljet National Park. [B/L/D]

**Day 4: Mljet, Dubrovnik**

After breakfast we depart for a pleasant cruise along the shores of Mljet and the Elaphite islands where we will have a swim stop and lunch arriving to Dubrovnik in the afternoon. Our own English-speaking guide and coach will come to the pier. After an organized transfer we will arrive to the historical centre of Dubrovnik, the famous city enlisted as UNESCO's World Heritage site, where your guide will show you the most interesting sights of Dubrovnik. After city tour you will be left on your own to explore the city, visit City Walls or take the cable car to the top of the Mount Srđ. Return coach transfer is scheduled in the evening or you can return on your own. You will see why this city is called the Pearl of the Adriatic. Overnight in Dubrovnik. [B/L]

**Day 5: Dubrovnik, Korčula**

After breakfast we will start our cruise to Korčula Island with a swim stop. Lunch on board and afternoon arrival to Korčula town, on Korčula Island. Korčula is a city known as a birthplace of Marko Polo, the famous explorer. Our English-speaking guide will do Korčula City tour, and walk

us through narrow and cobbled streets. The rest of the evening is free to enjoy dining at one of the local restaurants of your choice. Overnight in Korčula Historical Town. [B/L]

### Day 6: Korčula, Makarska

Our voyage will continue towards Makarska with refreshing swim stop on our way passing by Pelješac Peninsula and its picturesque places on both sides, green with the olive and pine groves, vineyards and the low bush forests and Eastern side of Hvar Island. Lunch on board "en route" and afternoon arrival to Makarska on the mainland, "tourist Centre of Dalmatia" famous with its long beaches and nightlife, where we will spend the night. Overnight in Makarska. [B/L]

### Day 7: Makarska, Pucisca, Brač, Split

Upon crossing the Brač Channel we reach the largest coastal village on Brač Island called - Pučišća. Shiny and white stone facades rising amphitheatrically uphill make this place so unique and famous for its quarries from which stone was excavated to build limestone columns of the White House in Washington DC, The Parliament House in Vienna and many other famous buildings all over the world. Pučišća is also known for Stonemasonry School where students learn to carve local limestone with traditional and unconventional tools that have been used for centuries. In the afternoon hours we will return in Split.

In 1700-year-old the historic core of Split inscribed under UNESCO World Heritage - and within a short walk distance from our ship- stands the massive Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian, dating back to the 3rd A.D. In the course of time the Old Town of Split developed inside and around the Palace which included three Roman temples and a massive mausoleum. Join us for a walking tour and explore with our tour guide some of the numerous archaeological, historic and cultural sites of Split. Find your favorite restaurant for dinner, have a sip of wine or latte in one of many cafes on the pedestrian promenade called Riva and explore numerous shops in the city center. Overnight stay in Split. [B/L]

- The cabins are equipped with life jackets, safety and fire alarm as well as PA sound system.

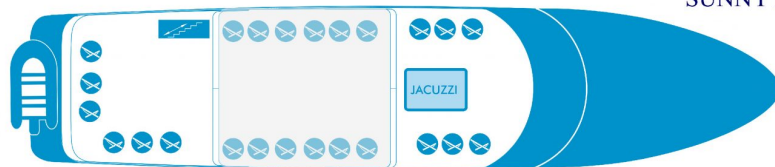


SUNNY DECK

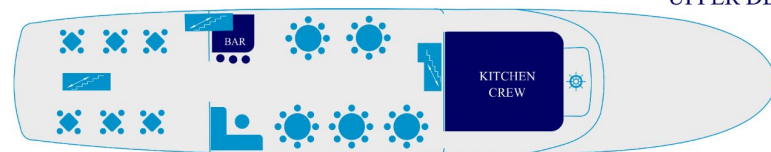
**Deck Plans**

**Main Deck**

There are 10 cabins measuring 140-160 sq. ft. with double or twin beds, including one cabin with third bed (not bunk bed). Each cabin has a large window and porthole in the bathroom.



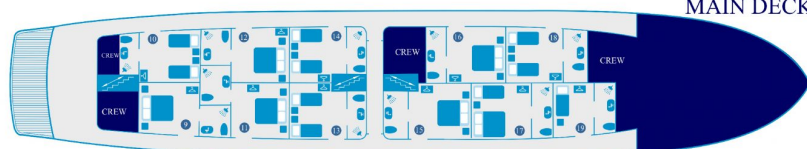
UPPER DECK



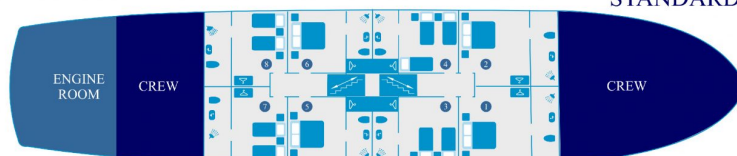
MAIN DECK

**Lower Deck**

There are 8 cabins measuring 150-172 sq. ft. with double or twin beds, including one cabin with third bed (not bunk bed). Lower deck cabins have entry doors from inside of the corridor. There are two portholes in each cabin as well as an additional dual ventilation system

**Amenities**

- Powered by two engines for an average cruising speed of 9 knots, few generators for 220 V electrical supply including full air conditioning, bow thruster and the latest electronic equipment.

- The M/S Captain Bota is a steel made vessel where mahogany and iroko woods have been also applied for decking and flooring as well as insulation materials used according to the latest EU standards.
- Upper deck features a fully air-conditioned salon -restaurant with panoramic windows measuring over 100 square meters with an additional buffet breakfast corner, bar and an adjacent 70 square meter terrace for a breathtaking view. The terrace is equipped with deck chairs and tables and may be covered in case of unpleasant wind.
- Kitchen (galley) is made in accordance with the newest HACCP standards where Mediterranean and international meals are prepared for the guests on board.
- For swim lovers Captain Bota offers a swimming platform with 2 ladders with handrails for an easy access to the water as well as two outdoor showers and toilettes. Unlike bathroom towels the beach towels may be additionally rented on board.
- On the top most ship`s level there is a fenced sundeck which covers an area of 250 square meters with loungers at disposal to all the passengers on board as well as a rooftop Jacuzzi. For guests` additional comfort the sundeck is partly covered with sunshades.
