

**The Capital, Wines & Lakes
8 days – 7 nights
Santiago, Casablanca Valley, Matetic Vineyard, Pucón, Villarrica, Conguillio National Park
Wines, Discovery, Culture, Eco-Tourism, Relaxation**

Wine tourism has developed strongly in this region renowned for its white wines. In particular for the sauvignon blanc which reveals its best aromas on this cool climate terroir, located on the shores of the Pacific Ocean. Only a 1-hour from Santiago de Chile, the Casablanca Valley and its wine route are a must to discover wine-growing Chile. The Lake District in Argentina is located in the northernmost part of Patagonia and features a landscape made up of forests, mountain ranges, snow-capped peaks and of course, many lakes. As you explore this region of Argentina, you will realize how very beautiful and fascinating a simple landscape can be and what nature can do.

Day 1: Santiago

After your arrival in Santiago, meet your guide and relax during the 40-minute transfer to your hotel. Transfer from the hotel to the meeting point. Depending on your arrival time you may take a 5-mile bike tour entering the green spaces and the most outstanding historical places of downtown Santiago. Shady parks, trendy neighborhoods and introduction to the "Santiaguino" culture will make for a memorable afternoon.

Notes: Wear comfortable clothes and sunscreen. The bilingual guide will provide water, helmet and a green bike. This tour requires 15-minute transfer to and from the meeting point to the hotel.

Day 2: Santiago (Vega Central Market)

Meet your guide at the Vega Central, a traditional and famous market, where lively vendors, local restaurants and buyers from all economic means converge. The market stands out as a permanent point of popular life and metropolitan authenticity. We will go through each of its picturesque corridors and we will come into contact with aromas, colors and a variety of typical Chilean and Latin American products. Continue towards Vega Chica, where "garzones" and tenants will do their best to serve us. We'll end up in the Central Market, famous for its architecture and variety of fish and seafood stalls. Taste some typical snacks before returning to the hotel. [S]

Day 3: Santiago (Casablanca Valley, Matetic Vineyard)

Casablanca Valley: Chile's move toward cool-climate viticulture began 25 years ago when innovative winemakers dared to suggest planting in the pre-coastal region of Casablanca Valley. When you arrive at the vineyard, you can choose one of the available optional activities such as biking, horseback riding or hiking. Either of these activities will allow you to enjoy a unique experience, allowing you to discover the essence of the Chilean countryside, weaved between native forests, sheep and alpacas. It is a fantastic outdoor excursion where the native flora and fauna of the wine valley provide an unforgettable atmosphere of tranquility. Afterwards you can enjoy the Corralillo Tour, beginning at the Wine Cellar, where you will be warmly welcomed by a bilingual guide who will take you through the different sections of the cellar and complete the tour by enjoying panoramic views of the vineyards. The tour is not complete without indulging in a wine tasting to savor the different flavors you've been learning about on the tour. After working up your appetite, you'll be taken to Restaurant Equilibrio to browse and enjoy a delicious lunch menu. [B/L/W]

Day 4: Santiago, Pucón

Transfer from your hotel to Santiago's airport to board your flight to Temuco, in Chile's Lake Region, from where you'll be transferred to your hotel in Pucón located 55 miles from the airport. [B/D]

Day 5: Pucón (Villarrica Volcano)

Today we will start our journey visiting the Villarrica Volcano, famous worldwide for being one of the most active in Chile and in all of South America. Our vehicle will climb up to 4,100 feet above sea level,

where the ski center is located, to enjoy the incredible panoramic views of the Llama volcano and the Villarrica, Calafquén and Huilipilún lakes. There we will have free time to take pictures and tour the sector. Then, return the hotel for dinner and overnight. [B/D]

Day 6: Pucón (Conguillio National Park)

The town of Melipeuco, 77 miles from Pucón, is where we start the trip to one of the most relevant places in the region: The Conguillio National Park. The park is characterized by its massive forests, and here we mainly see araucarias, along with other species, as well as pure and crystal-clear waters lakes; amongst the main park's attractions we could mention the Llama Volcano, the Green, Rainbow, Captrén and Quepe lagoons. The Conguillio Lake (located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada Glacier and framed by abundant native vegetation. Objects found in the area and innumerable indigenous names for places the former presence of Pehuenche people. Here we find six excursion footpaths leading to as many breathtaking places and points of view. Some of the animals we can see here are the Little Bush Monkey, world's smallest marsupial, the Condor, the eaglet and several types of water birds. Lava paths were naturally formed by flows of lava that came down during one of the many Llama's eruptions, this volcano is 10,265 feet above sea level, providing a great view of the national park and of the amazing lava formations which are hardly seen in any other part of the world. Return to Pucón for dinner and overnight. [B/D]

Day 7: Pucón, Santiago

After breakfast, transfer to Temuco airport for your flight to Santiago. On arrival take the Hilton Garden shuttle van to the hotel. [B]

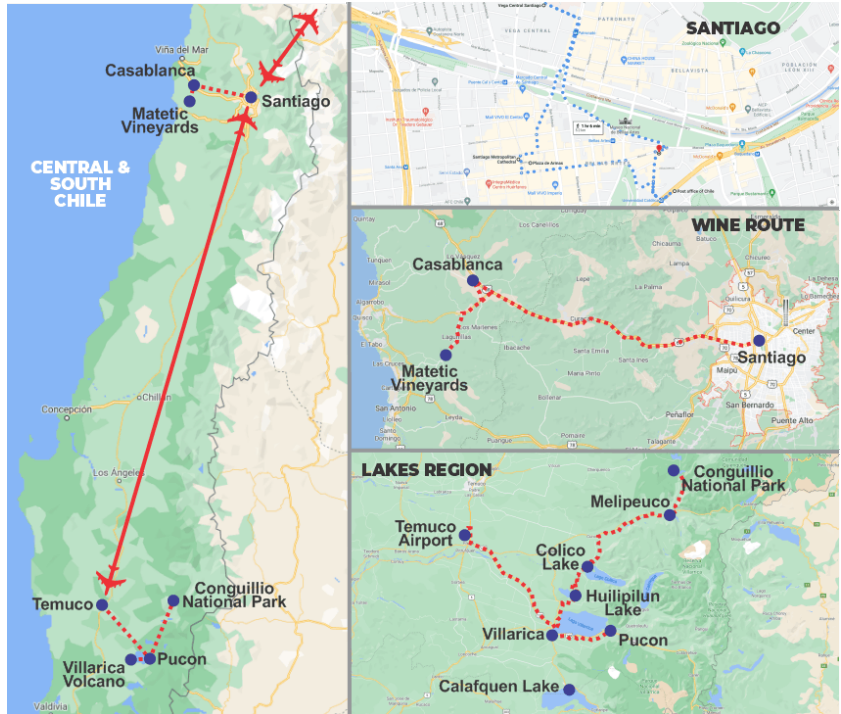
Day 8: Santiago, USA
