Zambia's National Parks are amongst the best in Africa. The adventure begins in South Luangwa, here you can view an abundant variety of game, including four of the big five – just missing Rhino -. From wildlife to waterfalls – the largest waterfall in the world, Victoria Falls. The final national park on this great tour is Liuwa Plains. Not as popular as the two previous parks but no less special, Liuwa Plains is a remote park which sees a lot less visitors, it offers fantastic game viewing and a stunning landscape.

Day 1: Lilongwe, Mfuwe, South Luangwa

Welcome to Malawi! After immigration formalities catch your flight to Mfuwe Airport where you will be transferred to Kakuli Lodge in Southern Luangwa National Park. Dinner and overnight at the lodge. [D]

Days 2-3: South Luangwa (Kakuli, Chinzombo)

Kakuli boasts a wonderful location on an elevated stretch of riverbank, overlooking a wide grazing lawn that follows the Luangwa River until it meets its confluence with the Luwi. There are four walk-in Meru style tents, with thatched roofs, cozy beds, bedside tables, simple wardrobes and large shady verandas. Activities consist of morning and afternoon game drives, Kakuli also really encourages walking safaris and you can easily combine many camps with these excursions, stopping and staying a few nights at a range of different lodges and camps, in this case Chinzombo. You are also able to enjoy fly camping, where you will embark on a walking safari and stop overnight within the banks of a dried-up river bed with just the stars (and a mosquito net!) as your canopy (weather dependent). Days 3-4: Chinzombo

Luxurious yet also elegantly natural, Chinzombo Camp is tucked into the shade of ancient trees on a bend of the Luangwa River. Six beautiful villas combine a modern architectural feel with natural materials such as leather, reeds and canvas. Each beautifully situated villa boasts its own private plunge pool and is situated on an elevated deck that boasts views of the tranquil river. Bedrooms open out onto shaded decks, while each villa also has a yoga and exercise area. Venture into one of the most game rich areas of the national park with our award-winning guiding team. The South Luangwa is renowned for its world-class predator action, with especially strong sightings of the elusive leopard. Explore the region's diverse habitats with game drives, safari walks and boat cruises (seasonal). [B/L/D]

Day 5: South Luangwa, Victoria Falls/Livingstone

A last game drive before you transfer to Mfuwe to board your flight to Victoria Falls. Upon arrival you'll be met and transferred to Tongabezi Lodge for dinner and overnight. [B/D]

Day 6: Tongabezi

Zambia's Tongabezi Lodge is an exclusive lodge located on the banks of the Zambezi River, 10 miles upstream from the magnificent Victoria Falls. Tongabezi is set in a grove of African ebony trees on a sweeping bend of the Zambezi River. The lodge has an extensive variety of Cottages and Houses catering to all guests and groups. Sindabezi Island is a castaway dream on a white sand beach surrounded by the Zambezi a short boat ride from the main jetty. Tongabezi also offers thrilling boat trips to the incredible Livingstone Island in the middle of Victoria Falls. [B/L/D]

Day 7: Tongabezi, Victoria Falls

Early morning head to Victoria Falls National Park for an exciting game drive. As you drive through

the park's impressive landscape, keep an eye out for native wildlife and learn about the array of African flora and fauna. Expect to see majestic animals including elephants, lions, buffalo, leopards, giraffes, zebra, and more. In mid-morning arrive at Victoria Falls where the raging waters of the Zambezi River crash into the Batoka Gorge. Marvel at this impressive feat of nature while soaking up the view and listening to your guide share fascinating insight about the area's wildlife, history, and geology. Stop for lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, it's time for your sunset cruise along the majestic Zambezi River. Onboard, you'll be treated to some tasty snacks and drinks as you meander along the river. Gaze upon the lush landscape that surrounds you as it is transformed by the colors of the sunset. During the cruise, you'll also see plenty of hippos and crocodiles as well as an abundance of birds. At the end of an unforgettable adventure, you will be dropped off back at your lodge. [B/L/D]

Day 9: Tongabezi, Livingstone, Lewaneka

After breakfast, transfer to Livingstone for a short flight to Kalabo, the southern entrance to Liuwa Plains where King Lewanika Lodge will pick you up for a short helicopter* ride to the lodge. [B/D]

* Helicopter rides are available up to 4 passengers. For larger parties we'll arrange appropriate transportation

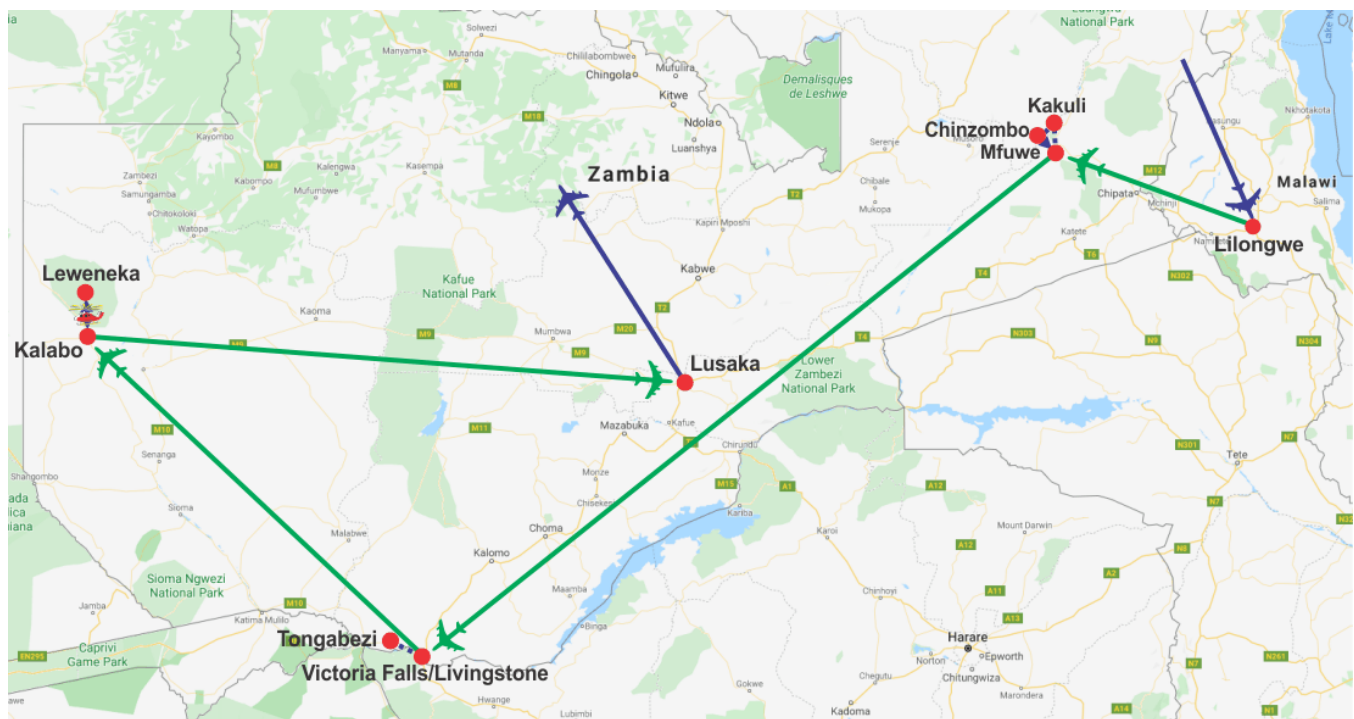
Days 10-11: King Leweneka, Liuwa Plains
