The ideal time to visit the Highlands is from April to September. The months of May and September are apparently the best weather, according to the locals. But you may visit in February and have sunshine! It will be cool for sure, but the advantage of Scotland is that the weather changes quickly. Heading to the Loch Ness, you'll find this beautiful lake is immersed in mystery thanks to a long, thin, green creature that surrounds the deep waters and occasionally raises its head above the water for a photo

Day 1 - Fri: Edinburgh

Upon your arrival at Edinburgh airport you'll be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel in the city. You also receive entrance tickets for the Edinburg Castle. The rest of the day is on your own but, we recommend spending the afternoon walking through the city, strolling along the Royal Mile and exploring the Old and New Towns, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. There are also plenty of museums and landmarks to visit within the city center, including the majestic Edinburgh Castle. Spend the night in Edinburgh.

Day 2: Edinburgh, Dunkeld, Inverness

Start your road trip driving into the Highlands. On the way you'll have many possible stops, such as the picturesque village of Dunkeld and the 13 -century Blair Castle. Driving through the Cairngorms National Park you could also stop at the Highland Folk Museum. Arriving near Inverness, you can drive to the Battlefield of Culloden Moor, to see where the last battle on British soil occurred in 1746, marking "the beginning of the end for the Highlands." Nearby you can visit Clava Cairns, a series of tombs and standing stones dating back roughly 4,000 years. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Inverness. [B/D]

Day 3: Inverness, Loch Ness, Portree

Today's journey will take you from Inverness to the famous Isle of Skye. Drive along the shores of Loch Ness and, if you have time, take a boat tour in search of its notorious and elusive monster, or go explore the nearby Urquhart Castle ruins. Further along the drive, make a stop at the iconic Eilean Donan Castle. When you arrive on Skye, your first stop will be at the scenic village of Portree, where you can explore and admire its colorful buildings and dine at a local restaurant. Spend the night on the Isle of Skye or nearby. [B/D]

Day 4: Portree, Trotternish, Glenfinnan, Fort William

Start the day early to explore Skye, a haven for nature lovers. Drive around the northern part of the island via the breathtaking Trotternish Peninsula, passing "The Old Man of Storr", one of Skye's most famous landmarks. On the way you can see the beautiful Kilt Rock Waterfall and enjoy the scenery of the Quiraing. Later, head to the Sleat Peninsula and catch the ferry to the mainland. On your drive to Fort William stop at Glenfinnan where you can visit the Glenfinnan Monument, overlooking Loch Shiel, and admire the Glenfinnan Viaduct, featured in Harry Potter. We'll have dinner at a local restaurant or the hotel. Spend the night in the Fort William area. [B/D]

Day 5: Fort William, Glen Coe, Stirling, Glasgow

Today, drive across the Trossachs National Park and Loch Lomond area and continue to Glasgow. This journey takes you past the magnificent Glen Coe, Scotland's most famous and scenic valley. For a fun

photo opportunity, don't miss the Doune Castle, featured in Monty Python & the Holy Grail and Outlander. If time allows, you could also stop by Stirling Castle, one of Scotland's top attractions, or at the impressive Kelpies, two giant horse-head sculptures. Spend the night in Glasgow. [B]

Day 6: Glasgow

After breakfast we leave the hotel for a tour of the city starting at George Square and continuing to Glasgow Cathedral, St Enoch, St Vincent Place and Argyle Street. Then, we visit Clydeside Distillery for a taste of local whisky. Continue to Kelvin Park, the University of Glasgow, Charing Cross. and the Theatre Royal. The rest of the day is free for shopping. [B]

Day 7: Glasgow, USA

At the appointed time you'll be picked up by our driver for your transfer to the airport to board your flight back to the USA. [B]
