Falklands (Malvinas), South George Island & Antarctica 19 days – 18 nights

Punta Arenas, Port Stanley, Saunders Island, Carcass Island, Bleaker Island, Elsehul Bay, Grytviken, Fortuna Bay, Stromness, Salisbury Plain, Prion Island, St Andrews Bay, Cooper Bay, Elephant Island, Antarctic Peninsula, South Shetland Islands, Ushuaia

This program is fully customizable and may be operated for individuals, pods and small groups

The remote islands of the Southern Ocean are magical places that will greet you with their awe-inspiring beauty. In the Falkland Islands (Islas Malvinas) see peaceful bays rich in wildlife and learn about the daily life of the people who make this remote outpost of British culture home. In South Georgia, be amazed by sharp snowy peaks that jut out of the sea and take in some of the largest wildlife colonies in the world. A land that holds 90% of Earth's ice, Antarctica stuns visitors with its breathtaking beauty. Enjoy peaceful bays dotted with colossal icebergs; cruise along deep fjords and see massive glaciers.

Day 1 - Fri: Punta Arenas

After passing entry formalities, take the shuttle to the hotel. This afternoon you may opt to visit the Explorers House to relax, hear the experiences of other cruise travelers and browse books about Antarctica.

Day 2 – Sat: Punta Arenas, Port Stanley

This morning, take the hotel shuttle to the airport and board your flight to the Falklands. On arrival, you'll be picked-up at the airport and driven to Port Stanley for a town visit before embarkation to start your expedition. [B/D]

Note: This is an international flight (Falklands is a UK territory), so be prepared for the customs and migration formalities

Day 3 - Sun: Saunders Island, Carcass Island

During a morning visit to Saunders Island, we enjoy the long white-sand beach. A wilderness experience, the main attractions there are rockhopper penguins, nesting black browed albatross, and sub-Antarctic gentoo penguins. In the afternoon, we visit Carcass Island. There is an option for an easy hike to the settlement, bird watching, and a typical Falklands tea experience. [B/L/D]

Day 4 - Mon: Bleaker Island

Morning landing at Bleaker Island. This is a natural reserve with a famous bird area featuring a large variety of birds. In the afternoon, we head to South Georgia. [B/L/D

Days 5/6 - Tue/Wed: At Sea

South Georgia, your next stop, is a destination like no other. A symbiosis between the sea and the high mountains. This island is also a paradise for fauna, a consequence of the presence in its waters of very large quantities of krill (staple food for whales and other mammals and seabirds of the southern latitudes). Enjoy the fantastic ocean views from you cabin or deck. [B/L/D]

Day 7 - Wed: Elsehul Bay

Evening Zodiac cruise at Elsehul Bay, subject to crossing and permits from the South Georgia government. [B/L/D]

Day 8 - Thu: Grytviken, Fortuna Bay, Stromness

Morning landing at Grytviken, we will clear Customs here and then visit the historical site, with the museum and Ernest Shackleton's grave. In the afternoon, landing at Fortuna Bay/Stromness. We will see king penguins and learn more about Shackleton and his expedition. There is an optional 2-3 hour "Shackleton walk". [B/L/D]

Day 9 - Fri: Salisbury Plain, Prion Island

Morning visit to Salisbury Plain for more king penguins and stunning landscapes. In the afternoon, visit Prion Island to see the nesting wandering albatross. [B/L/D]

Day 10 - Sat: St Andrews Bay, Cooper Bay

Morning visit to St Andrews Bay. We will see the largest king penguin colony, and elephant seal bulls. In the afternoon, visit Cooper Bay to see macaroni penguins on a Zodiac cruise. [B/L/D]

Days 11/12 - Sun/Mon: At Sea

Follow in the steps of previous explorers to discover the immensity of the Antarctic ocean, see icebergs, frozen islands, experience

astonishing conditions changes and observe unique animal life during these 2-day sail. [B/L/D]



Day 13 - Tue: Elephant Island

In the afternoon, we will see Elephant Island. While a landing here is very unlikely, we will see the island from the ship or, if sea conditions allow, from a Zodiac. [B/L/D]

Day 14-17 – Wed/Sat: Antarctic Peninsula, Southern Islands

Cruise along the Antarctic Peninsula and among the South Shetland Islands, visiting sites in the Antarctic Sound and in the Gerlache Strait. The voyage may include visits to sites such as Gourdin Island, Brown Bluff, Half Moon Island, Deception Island, Wilhelmina Bay, the Lemaire Channel, Cuverville Island, the Melchior Islands or other magnificent places. [B/L/D]

Days 18/19 - Sun/Mon: At Sea

Be exposed to majestic expressions of nature. In the remote and extreme Antarctic and sub-Antarctic environment, travelers see and feel things that go beyond what they know and are used to in their daily lives. It's the same planet but it feels different. For many, it is a life-changing experience. [B/L/D]

Day 20 - Tue: Ushuaia, USA

Arrival in Ushuaia and transfer to the airport to board your connecting flight back home. [B]

Your Cruise:

Magellan Explorer is a new and modern expedition vessel custom built for our Antarctic and sub-Antarctic expeditions. The ship was constructed in Chile to the latest Polar Code specifications. Magellan Explorer has seven categories of accommodation, including dedicated single cabins. All cabins except Porthole cabins feature private balconies. The majority of double cabins have two twin beds that can be configured as one king-size bed. Some double cabins can only be configured with a queen-size bed. All cabins feature a wardrobe, individually controlled heating system, a sitting area, and a private bathroom with shower. The ship features a glass-enclosed observation lounge and presentation room with state-of-the-art audio-visual equipment, a spacious and stylish dining room, a well-stocked bar, a library, a meeting room, a gym, a sauna, and a medical clinic. The forward-facing observation deck leads to the bow of the ship, which is accessible to guests to offer proximity to marine wildlife. The ship has a fleet of 10 Zodiac boats that are well suited for disembarking and wildlife watching. The fitness center aboard Magellan Explorer has been designed and built by the professionals at Anytime Fitness, the world's only fitness company with boutique gyms in all seven continents.
