Glimpse of Bahrain 6 days – 5 nights Manama, Muharraq, Qal'at al-Bahrain Relaxation, Discovery, Culture, History This program may be operated for individuals or for groups

Bahrain is a small island located on an archipelago of the Persian Gulf in the Middle East, bordering Saudi Arabia. Its beaches offer the possibility of practicing many sports activities such as scuba diving and snorkeling. It is possible to hike in the capital and discover its important places such as the entrance to Souk Bab Al Bahrain, Al Fath Mosque and the National Museum. In this tour you'll find places that mark the history of the country such as the 15th century Arad fort, the archaeological site of Qal'at al-Bahrain representing the ruins of the ancient capital!

Day 1: Manama

After clearing immigration and Customs at Manama International Airport, meet our representative for a short drive to your hotel.

Day 2: Manama

This tour covers the best of Bahrain in one day. The incredible Musque Al Fateh. The National Museum brings you back over 4000 years of history, in the tradition, culture and customs of Bahrain. Bahrain Bay Island, where the modern buildings of Bahrain are located. The largest historical and archaeological site in the Gulf region, the Bahrain Fort site. Smile and enjoy the beauty of oriental flavors at Souk de Manama with an unforgettable chance to savor a traditional Bahraini lunch in one of the traditional cafes. Far from Manama to visit a camel farm, formula one circuit. Drive to the first oil well and the amazing tree of life in the middle of the desert. End the tour with a stop at the Royal Mounds of Ala'ali and the Pottery Workshop. [B/L]

Day 3: Manama (Muharraq walking tour)

This afternoon, you'll get an overview of Muharraq Old Town and information about Bahrain that you might never have heard of before. You'll will be fascinated by the old traditional Bahraini houses, their design, art and atmosphere. Each house tells a different story, speaking from the history of Bahraini pearl diving to current and traditional Bahraini art and design including exclusive entry to the Bahrain Pavilion and Bahrain Pearl Path Monument to learn the significance of pearl diver's existence throughout Bahrain's history. Finally, you're invited to a local Bahraini cafe and greeted by the owner, fully dressed in traditional Bahraini attire (thobe), for a dinner of chicken or beef Tikka, Bahraini Arabic tea, coffee, dates and sweets as you learn the ingredients of every drink and food you consume. Return to the hotel for overnight. [B/D]

Day 4: Manama (Dilmun Civilization)

Travel along ancient trading routes as you unearth the cultures, arts, and traditions of the Dilmun millennia-old people. We start at the Barbar Temples that are among the most remarkable architectural survivals of the ancient world without parallel in the region. The archaeologists found three temples built on top of each other belonging to different eras. Continue to Qal'at al-Bahrain Bahrain Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage site, that once was the center of power for the ancient Dilmun civilization and occupies a strategic military position. Excavations have revealed ancient soldier's barracks, horse stables, an ammunition depot, a secret passageway, ceramic utensils and Islamic and Chinese currency coins. Next, visit the archaeological Dilmun Burial Mounds of great historical importance going back to the Dilmun civilization in the third millennium BCE. The tour ends at the Bahrain National Museum, built on the edge of the sea, in itself a tremendous attraction with white travertine façade and dramatic courtyard decorated with contemporary sculptures. Return to the hotel. [B]
