

**Safari in Paradise**  
**Kilimanjaro, Arusha, Lake Manyara, Ngorongoro, Serengeti**  
**7 days/6 nights**

*During your private tailor-made safari, you will be accommodated in or near the parks as described below. The days will be spent giving you the best game viewing experience possible in each park, with either morning and afternoon game drives, or full day excursions. If you are opting to do a "drive-in" safari, the drives between parks may be broken with cultural visits to local villages, or historical hotspots and further game viewing, guaranteeing that your transfers are far from boring. Your itinerary is fairly flexible from day to day and options may be discussed with your guide before setting off for the day.*

### **Day 1: Kilimanjaro, Arusha**

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to your hotel in Arusha. The rest of the day is free to rest from the long trip and recuperate a little of your jet leg. Accommodation at the hotel.

### **Day 2: Arusha, Lake Manyara**

After breakfast, your driver/guide will meet you for the start of your safari with a drive to Lake Manyara. Enjoy a picnic lunch in Lake Manyara National Park during your game drive. This afternoon transfer to the Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge for accommodation in a standard room. Dinner at the lodge. [B/L/D]

### **Day 3: Lake Manyara, Ngorongoro**

After breakfast get ready for your next stop, Ngorongoro, considered the "Cradle of Mankind" and a sanctuary to most of the African animal species. You will travel for about 2 hours on a tarred road from Lake Manyara to Ngorongoro. The best part about this trip is that you may arrange with your driver/guide when and how to organize your day. We suggest you take an early morning game drive in Lake Manyara before heading to Ngorongoro and arrive at your destination in time for lunch. This way you balance your stay between the 2 parks. After you check-in and have lunch get a first look at the magnificent Ngorongoro Park with an afternoon game drive that you may schedule with your driver/guide. Then enjoy the peaceful sundown and dinner at the lodge before you retire for overnight. [B/L/D]

### **Day 4: Ngorongoro**

Today, after breakfast, head down into the Ngorongoro Caldera close to 2,000 ft. below the floor of the crater. Spend the day enjoying game viewing in one of the most spectacular places on earth! Photographic opportunities are abundant, and one often sees four of the Big Five in a short time (the Big Five are the African lion, African elephant, Cape buffalo, African leopard, and white/black rhinoceros). Explore the forest areas that are inhabited by monkey and elephant, the lake area, where you may see the flamingos and the open savannah where the lions hunt for food. Have a picnic lunch at the floor of the crater at a pleasant lakeside location where you can stretch your legs and soak up the magnificent scenery. Later in the afternoon, return to the lodge for dinner and overnight. [B/L/D]

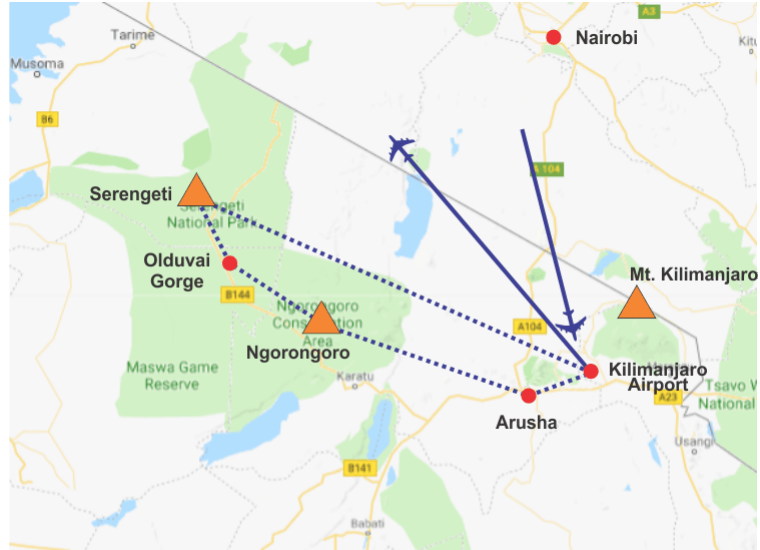
### **Days 5: Ngorongoro, Serengeti**

Enjoy breakfast at the lodge before leaving for central Serengeti with a stop en-route at Olduvai Gorge, site of Louis and Mary Leakey's renowned archaeological discoveries. Their findings include some of the man's earliest known ancestral remains. Continue to Serengeti National Park in time for lunch. The drive takes about 4 hours. This enormous park supports every variety of animals imaginable - from large predators such as lion, leopard and cheetah to the smaller herbivores they prey on. Since you are in

command of your days we suggest that you discuss with your driver/guide tomorrow's program so you can take advantage of the spectacular game viewing (either morning, full day or afternoon) in Serengeti National Park. Dinner and overnight at Serengeti Lodge. [B/L/D]

### Day 6: Serengeti

As usual breakfast will be served at the lodge. In his book *Venture to the Interior*, published in 1963, Laurens van der Post wrote: "... The only living things, which look as if they really belonged to it are the Wild Animals. Between the animals and Africa there is an understanding that the human beings have not yet earned...". The area comprised of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, Masai Mara Game Reserve and the Serengeti National Park protects the largest and most assorted concentration of wildlife on earth and maintains its natural ecosystem so well that the migratory cycles are kept practically intact. The Serengeti is the jewel of Tanzania's national parks and one of the greatest conservation areas in Africa. Today you spend the whole day on game drive in this National Park (if that was your choice), which is rich in all different species of animals. To give you a better chance of seeing the big five you will carry a picnic lunch with you and spend all the time in the Serengeti. After your safari, return to the lodge to enjoy your last evening in this "Paradise". Dinner and overnight at the Lodge. [B/L/D]



### Day 7: Serengeti, Kilimanjaro, USA

Enjoy your breakfast and be ready to return to Kilimanjaro's Airport by road. This is a long drive and you should book a late-night flight out. Alternatively, you can take an optional flight from Seronera airstrip to Kilimanjaro Airport. At the airport board your connecting flight for your return to the USA. [B]

Lake Manyara	Serena Lodge	Tripadvisor: 4
Standing high on the edge of a towering terracotta escarpment with panoramic views over the glittering alkaline waters of Lake Manyara, the lodge offers a unique blend of tranquility, wildlife discovery, and bird species richness. Grouped around a central "vanishing horizon" pool and a bar with stunning views over the lake. The rooms are housed in circular, double-story, white-washed "rondavels" (traditional circular buildings with conical thatched roofs), which are sprung out along the edge of the cliff so as to allow for maximum views. Each spacious circular room has its own small veranda while the interior decor reflects the blue of the lake and the pink of the flamingos.		
Ngorongoro	Serena Safari Lodge	Tripadvisor: 4
This unique lodge clings to the rim of the magnificent Ngorongoro Crater, the largest and most perfect volcanic crater on Earth. Long and low, the lodge is built from local river stone and camouflaged with indigenous vines. Designed to blend completely into the landscape, it is entirely invisible from the floor of the crater 1,970 ft. below. Hugging the contours of the jagged crater rim, the lodge takes its inspiration from the so-called "Cradle of Mankind", the prehistoric site of Olduvai Gorge, which lies close by. At the stone heart of the lodge burns a glowing fire, which is kept constantly alight. Decorated with cave paintings, the rooms are strung around the crater rim. Each has its own rock-enclosed balcony, and all enjoy completely uninterrupted views of the volcanic amphitheater far below.		
Serengeti	Serena Safari Lodge	Tripadvisor: 4.5
Set high on the saddle of a tree-clad ridge, commanding panoramic views across the Serengeti, the lodge is the ultimate fusion of traditional African architecture and world-class style. A series of traditional domed "rondavels" are widely spaced throughout the grounds, which are cooled by groves of acacia trees and watered by sparkling streams. On the very edge of the ridge is a "vanishing horizon" pool, which looks out over the endless plains after which the Serengeti is named. Each charmingly presented room is accommodated in a two-story (one up, one down) stone-built, traditionally thatched rondavel. Looking out over the plains, each has its own private balcony, private entrance, spacious bedroom, natural stone bathroom and intricately carved furniture.
