Seattle has a unique vibe and so far removed from other urban centers across the country that it has had to develop its own culture. Resting between Puget Sound and Lake Washington, primary outdoor activities include kayaking, hiking, and camping. Without forgetting the proximity to the Olympic mountains and the giant Mount Rainier which are visible from many spots in the city.

Day 1: Everett, Seattle

Upon arrival in Seattle airport, pickup your car rental and drive downtown to check-in at your hotel. Rest of the day free to start discovering Seattle on your own.

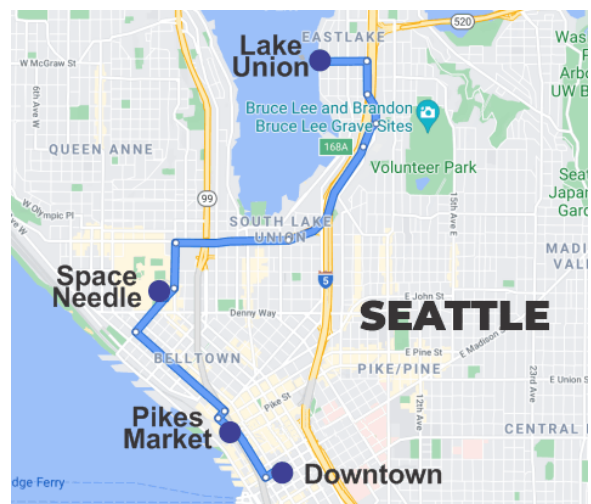
Day 2: Seattle

This morning drive 25 miles north to Everett where the Boeing Future of Flight (Boeing Field), one of Seattle's most popular attractions, is located. Experience panoramic views from the Sky Deck including the North Cascades mountain range. Then, take a front row access to daily flight operations activity that includes private aircraft, commercial flights, and testing of our newest airplanes. The Boeing Tour is an opportunity to view 747, 767, 777 planes and the 787-Dreamliner on the assembly line before they depart to begin service. The Boeing Factory Tour is a visit inside a working assembly plant, which can be noisy and active depending on the day and time. Each tour is approximately 90 minutes long and includes fascinating facts about Boeing and the planes that bear its name. After the tour head back to Downtown Seattle. In the afternoon visit Pike Place Market that offers many retail shops and attractions to explore. Maybe you'll find a good place for lunch. Plenty of guides talk about the Gum Wall, Rachel the Pig, flying fish, and the "first" Starbucks. Perhaps do some shopping, or stop for a nosh. We are sure you'll likely find something in this interesting place.

Day 3: Seattle

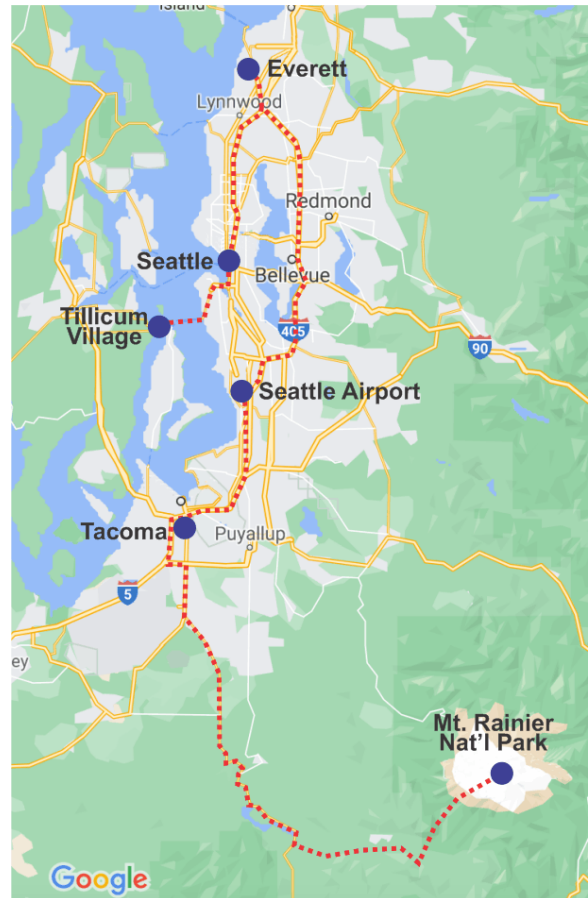
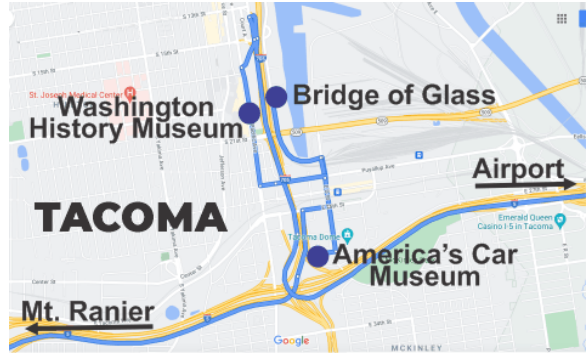
Today, drive along the ocean to Seattle Center Space needle and experience two entirely new levels of thrills! From an all-glass floor on the lower level to floor-to-ceiling glass on the upper level enjoy the best panoramic views of the Emerald City. Continue your discovery with a short drive to Lake Union to see the houseboats. The Seattle Floating Home community represents a unique way of life, balancing urban living with nature. Today, the docks also provide a sanctuary for wildlife such as beaver, otters, eagles and blue herons that are no longer found in other metropolitan areas of this size. To end your afternoon drive to the end of East Pier and find the cruise departure point at Lake Union Piers. Enjoy an unforgettable dining experience aboard a beautiful Waterways yacht — complete with the finest culinary offerings, friendly, attentive service, and stunning views of Seattle's lakes and city skylines. This two-and-a-half-hour cruise will take you to Lake Union and Lake Washington starting with Champagne or sparkling cider toast upon boarding. Then, seat down at your own private table to enjoy a delicious plated dinner listening to the Captain's narration of sights. Specialty cocktails,



wine, beer, and non-alcoholic beverages together with appetizers and specialty entrees available for purchase

Day 4: Seattle (Mt. Rainier, Tacoma)

No trip to Washington State is complete without a Mount Rainier experience! Leave for the park as soon as possible (about 1:45 drive) and join one of the available activities. Stroll through a temperate inland rainforest in spring. Hike with the wildflowers and gaze upon powerful waterfalls in the summer. Marvel at the fall colors each autumn. Discover epic skiing, snowboarding, and snowshoeing each winter. And fall in love with the world-class vistas that re-define spectacular year-round. Visit a wildlife park, follow a drive tour, take the scenic Mt. Rainier Gondola... In the afternoon had to Tacoma and pay a visit the Chihuly Bridge of Glass a stunning link to the Thea Foss Waterway and the Museum of Glass. The 500-foot pedestrian bridge holds three amazing Chihuly glass installations. From Pacific Avenue, you'll cross under the arches of the Washington State History Museum and arrive at the first glass installation, the Sea Form Pavilion with a variety of sculptures throughout, including some of the largest ever blown. You'll emerge from the Bridge with a new appreciation of glass art. Continue to the Washington State Museum of History to discover the stories of Washington's past. Explore and be entertained while you learn about the state's unique people and places and their impact on the country and the world. It's an experience filled with interactive exhibits and displays, theatrical storytelling and dramatic artifacts. The last item on your list is LeMay-America's Car Museum (ACM), a destination for families and auto enthusiasts to celebrate America's love affair with the automobile and to learn how it shaped our society. Recognized as one the best automotive museums worldwide, it serves as an educational center for students of all ages, features 12 rotating exhibits and hosts five annual Signature Events. After the visit, drive back to Seattle for overnight.



Day 5: Seattle, Home Town

Depending on your flight schedule you may have some time to say good bey to Seattle. Make sure you leave with ample time to the airport, (25-minute drive depending on traffic conditions) to drop-off your car and board your flight back home.
