

Untamed Tukano Cruise
5 days – 4 nights
Manaus, Negro River, Solimões River, Apuaú River
Ecotourism, Wellness, Meditation, Relaxation

This itinerary was created for a wellness experience to disconnect from every day's hectic digital world and connect with the mysteries and natural wonders of the Amazon. Leaving Manaus and going up the Rio Negro, discover countless natural attractions, many of them untouched, meet local indigenous communities with rituals led by a shaman, enjoy the immensity of the forest, meeting the waters and isolated beaches of rare beauty.

Day 1: Manaus

On arrival in Manaus you'll be met by our representative for a historic tour of the city. Explore the city of Manaus with a dedicated guide on this private tour. Learn about the rubber boom in Brazil and its effects on the history and culture of the city through engaging commentary from your guide. Visit the Negro River Palace, the Manaus Opera House, a transformed park, and the City of Manaus Museum. Peruse the Adolpho Lisboa market, where rows of vendors sell fresh Amazonian fish, local produce, and traditional handicrafts. After the tour you'll be dropped at your hotel for overnight.

Day2: Manaus (Boarding)

At 8:00 am a representative of the Untamed Amazon Cruise will meet you at your hotel reception for transfer to the Pier to check-in at 8:30 am on the boat for passenger accommodation, welcome drinks and snacks on board. Start of browsing on Rio Negro to the Anavilhanas archipelago, about 50 km above Manaus, where there are approximately 400 islands, hundreds of lakes, rivers, holes and streams that make it the second largest fluvial archipelago in the world. Lunch on board - in the afternoon, departure from motorboat to meet the sustainable community of Tumbira - where they use solar energy to live. Canoe tour at sunset and at night, dinner on board and appetizers. [B/L/D]

Day 3: Negro River

After breakfast, motorized boat tour to visit the rubber plantation museum and learn a little about the golden age of rubber in the Amazon and how the rubber soldiers' daily life was. Lunch on board. Navigation to the large beach for swimming in the river and watching the sunset. Dinner on board. In the evening, we will depart by speedboat for a reconnaissance tour of the area to observe the nightlife. Overnight on board. [B/L/D]

Day 4: Amazon River

Breakfast on board, Departure for a walk in the riverside community, Tumbir, for social action and to get to know the plantations and the Sustainable project of this community. Lunch on board. In the afternoon tour in rowing canoes through the region of Rio Apuaú to get to know a little of about its

fauna and flora (possibly observe sniffing monkeys, sloth, millenary tree Sumaúma, amazonian flowers etc.). Sunset in the jungle and night life observation, possible alligator watching. Dinner and overnight on board. [B/L/D]

Day 5: Amazon River, Manaus, USA

Breakfast on board and departure to observe the Amazon dolphins and visit the Tuyuka Indigenous community to discover their culture and crops growing technique. Return to the boat for lunch on board and disembark at 1:00 pm for transfer to the airport. [B/L]



Notes: The itinerary is subject to be change according to the weather situation or the level of the rivers. Day-to-day activities are approximate. The exact order of days and characteristics can be changed due to navigation or other itinerary considerations.

Difficulty: Good health is required. Many travelers can have an enjoyable trip simply by staying aboard the Untamed Amazon and participating in boat tours. Participants of walking tours must be able to walk through two hours on each tour. There are several daily excursions off the boat.

100% Solar energy

Untamed Amazon is a pioneer in the Amazon in the use of solar energy to supply 100% of the boat's electrical network, replacing diesel generation. The system of solar panels, lithium batteries and inverters is the most advanced in photovoltaic generation technology. The reduction in carbon dioxide emissions is equivalent to planting one tree a day.

Non-plastic

The river water is treated by three filtration processes (including reverse osmosis) plus three purification processes (chlorination, UV light and ozone) and distributed pure and potable in the boat. We eliminate plastic water bottles, and in partnership with YETI we offer excellent reusable thermal containers to our customers. The sewage are treated in bio-digesters and transform the residual water that after chlorination returns cleanly to the river.

International service

The cuisine aboard the Untamed Amazon is prepared by international chefs who blend Amazonian ingredients with modern techniques. To accompany our meals, we offer fine wines (stored in a temperature- controlled cellar), local favorite caipirinhas with tropical fruits, and specialty beers.

Luxury accommodations

We offer eight comfortable air-conditioned suites, each with private bathrooms. Our vessels have satellite phones and panoramic windows with extraordinary views of the Amazon. The upper floor has a spacious living and dining room and an open lounge.
