Departing from Venice, set off on a journey wrapped in adventure and romance. Journey towards musical Vienna before arriving in extravagant Paris. Your two nights aboard the train will be full of moments to cherish. Dine on world-class cuisine, be spoilt by the peerless service of your personal steward, or simply watch the scenery unfold from the comfort of your cabin.

Day 1: Venice

On your arrival at Venice airport you'll be met by our representative and driven by private car to your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to rest and relax.

Day 2: Venice

This UNESCO World Heritage Site is different from any other because of its topography characterized by more than one hundred islands and a Grand Canal in a lagoon on the Adriatic coast of Italy. Venice has been the crossroads of cultures and civilizations that are the inspiration of magnificent palaces, ancient bridges, Gothic, Renaissance and Byzantine artworks. The gondolas, known in the entire world add a romantic dimension to this city so special in so many ways. Your 2-hour walking tour will bring you to many of these artistic treasures and, especially, to Piazza San Marco with the Doge's Palace and basilica and domes. Then, Climb aboard a traditional gondola for a romantic excursion through the city's canals. Sit back and enjoy exploring the city and looking at its architectural treasures from the water! The rest of the day is free so you can enjoy the city on your own, so do some shopping or relax at one of the cafes. Overnight in Venice. [B]

Day 3: Venice, Vienna

Board the VSOE train at Venice Santa Lucia station. Once you have settled into your cabin, you will have some time to explore the train. A delicious 4-course dinner will be served in the restaurant car. After dinner you may wish to join your fellow guests in the Bar Car. [B/D]

Day 4: Vienna

Breakfast is served in your cabin before arriving at Vienna station in the morning. Transfer to your chosen hotel for a 2-night stay. Rest of the day free. Tonight, exclusive dinner on the Ferris-wheel in the Prater attractions/amusement park. In your private cabin you can enjoy the captivating view of the city. Furthermore, you enjoy a full romantic environment during a candlelight dinner which has been prepared especially for you. [B/D]

Day 5: Vienna

In the morning you enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vienna in a traditional Fiaker, which is the best way to go back to the old Vienna and enjoy the experience aboard the traditional horse-drawn carriage. Austria's current capital and the former capital of the Austrian-Hungarian empire is one of the most important cultural centers in Europe and one of the most romantic cities in the world. Visit the city's famous operas and beautiful parks, admire the Baroque architecture and the Prater. Listen to classical music, explore the home town of composers such as Beethoven, Mozart or Haydn and sample the world-renowned chocolate Sachertorte. You also visit the Hofburg and the palace of Schönbrunn. In the evening enjoy a gala dinner with live classical music. [B/D]

Day 6: Vienna, Paris

This morning you'll have a car and chauffeur-guide at your disposal to visit the sites that interest you

more. In the afternoon, re-join the VSOE train for a selection of pastries served by your steward in the comfort of your cabin. A leisurely 4-course dinner is served. Prepared on board by our skilled French chefs. Enjoy a brandy or liqueur with convivial company in the Bar Car before retiring for the night. [B/D]

Day 7: Paris

Continental breakfast is brought to you by your steward in the comfort of your private cabin before arrival at Gare de l'Est in Paris where you'll be met by our guide for a tour starting with a visit to the spectacular Notre Dame Cathedral. Enjoy the magnificent view of the Eiffel Tower. See the Arc de Triomphe, one of the most famous monuments in Paris and continue to the Opera, designed by Charles Garnier for Emperor Napoleon III. It is the most important symbol of the 19th century Second Empire baroque style. Visit the Greek temple Madeleine and the Great Louvre, the largest national museum of France, the most visited museum in the world and a historic monument. It is a central landmark of Paris. Enjoy a walk along Champs-Elysees, the most prestigious avenue in Paris. Visit the majestic Palace of Versailles, one of the world's grandest historical museums. See the Royal Apartments, the Hall of Mirrors, the Queen's Chamber... and learn more about France's history. Return to Paris for check-in and a quick wash-up before dinner at one of Paris' gourmet restaurants. [B/D]

Day 8: Paris, USA

At the appointed time you' be met by our representative and driven to Orly Airport to board your flight back to the USA. [B]


